In South Africa, about 40% of students who start school in Grade 1 ultimately drop out before they reaching and finishing Grade 12

- The school drop-out rate is of particular concern because students who drop out of school prematurely often experience a lack of access to higher education, fewer job opportunities and lower wages than their peers who complete their schooling
- A large percent of young dropouts are either unemployed or not in any further education or training. The rate of engagement in highrisk behaviours such as premature sexual activity, teenage pregnancy, delinquency, crime, violence, alcohol and drug abuse, and suicide has found to be significantly higher among dropouts.



There is only one High School in Ocean View with a Zero Tolerance approach which tends to lead to a significant amount of drop-outs among students who struggle academically
